From the Stewardship Committee

Stewardship, of course, includes the administration, governance and operation of our church. We have our Minister, our Office Administrator, our Official Board with several board committees who are doing their best to promote the mission and ministry of First United. Included and equally important is every individual in our congregation who give of their time, talents and financial resources towards making our Mission Statement a reality.

In our tradition the main focus of our Stewardship Committee is financial matters. We receive funds, create and maintain detailed contribution and accounting records, make bank deposits and ensure that our church's financial obligations are met. We also feel an obligation to periodically, at least in a general sense, inform our church members just how we're doing.

We believe that in many ways we are recovering from the challenges of Covid while another challenge is approaching. Summer is the time when people travel more, take vacations, make better use of cottages etc. – all good things which help us re-energize after the winter and enjoy life to a greater degree. The other side of this is that when folks are out of town both church attendance and revenues are significantly less. At this time you probably know the different ways to contribute; i.e. Pre- Authorized Remittance, post- dated cheques, church drop-box and E-transfer.

Here is our financial position for the period January 31, 2023 to May 31, 2023 which we hope will be helpful to you.

Operating expenses \$101,364.34 **Operating revenue** \$81,185.70 **Deficit \$20,178.64**

Building fund expenses \$ 18,376.86 Building Fund revenue \$ 14,066.50 Deficit \$ 4,310.36

We are thankful every day for all those people who give so generously in many ways and we fully realize that everyone is just not able to support our church at the same level. Our request is that you prayerfully consider what you can do to help our church in (as part of our Mission statement says) "spreading the love of God through worship, caring, sharing and outreach".
