### LIGHTING OF THE ADVENT WREATH

**READERS:** (Rose Whiteway, Anna Goodland, Nicholas Goodland) What do you do when an angel interrupts your day?

You stop.

What do you do when an angel speaks?

You listen.

The angels interrupted the shepherds' nighttime routine.

They stopped. They listened.

The angels had a message for the shepherds.

"A child of peace is born."

But the shepherds trembled and said, "We're afraid."

The angels said, "Rejoice. Be glad, for you will find the child lying in a manger."

Remembering Zechariah and Elizabeth, we light this candle of Possibility.

ALL: In the circle of God's light, all things are possible.

(Light one blue candle)

#### **READERS:**

Remembering Mary, we light this candle of Risk.

ALL: In the circle of God's light, we dare to risk.

(Light a second blue candle)

#### **READERS:**

Remembering the shepherds, we light this candle of Joy.

ALL: In the circle of God's light, we live with joy.

(Light a third (pink) candle)

**SUNG RESPONSE:** Angels, from the realms of glory,

(unison) sing to shepherds in the field.

You who sang creation's story, now proclaim Messiah's birth:

come and worship, come and worship,

worship in this Advent time.

**Prayer of Approach:** (unison)

Holy God, scattering the proud, you look with favour on those the world ignores. In Advent we wait for the One who will feed us; who stands with us in our loneliness and pain; who fills the hunger of our hearts; who lifts us from our hopelessness; in him, all the promises come true. Holy One, for you, we wait, even as we worship today. Amen.
